### This auction will be held in North Kansas City in the same place you have been coming to for the last 5 years. Rules and procedures for this auction are the same as they have been for the last 5 years except:

- 1) Viewing on Tuesday April 23 will end early at 5:00 p.m.
- 2) You only have until Friday 3 May 2024 to come shop or pickup at the North Kansas City location.

**About this Auction:** This auction features some new items that you have not gotten to see before from a collection in Kentucky as well as a couple of local collections that we have finally had the pleasure of going through. There will be some lots from previous auctions with price cuts that this will be the last time you see them in this order. The next time you see them will be in big box lots for probably a higher price. So make sure you are bidding on those items you might want so you don't lose them later.

**Sunday Viewing:** If you need to make arrangements to visit on Sunday please remember these appointments are only for those driving more than 75 miles. The doors to the auction floor will open at 12:45 on Sunday April 28, 2024 and we will begin auctioning at 13:30 or when Ashley strolls over after she chats with everyone. :)

**Payment:** Cash, Check and Credit cards are still accepted. There is a 3% fee to cover the processing companies fees.

**Shipping:** Shipping will still be handled the same. The local handling fee of \$10.00 plus 5% will be added to orders if you live within 75 miles as the crow flies. If you are local and need us to hold your item instead of paying the "extra" we can do that but depending on when you will be back in town it might be a little longer till you pick up. (see next paragraph)

#### The clown is getting a new home.

I can now, officially, tell everyone that we are moving to Claycomo, MO. I bought the building—so this will be my last move. Many of you have visited the area before because, the last two Greater Kansas City Stamp Shows were held almost next door in the Claycomo Community Building.

E&D will be moving into what was, until recently, the landmark El Sombrero restaurant. The owners made the tough decision last year to hang up the "family apron" and they have allowed us to purchase the building. We are very grateful for the opportunity to move into our own building and stop paying rent.

It's also 6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> miles closer to home for both of us. It may be a little further away for some of you (an extra 7 miles) but, most of you only come by twice a quarter while we are both there at least 4 or 5 times every week.. We hope you will still attend; but if 7 more miles is just too much—"Sorry to see you go—goodbye, goodbye, goodbye."

We are hoping to have a small research area that you are welcome to visit. Bring your stamps *during non-auction weeks* and look at them with the microscope, use the Signoscope on them, shine the UV lights on them or just use our books and catalogs for research.

We have always wanted more of a community style stamp place, where you could ask questions about a stamp, look at the stamp under a bigger magnifying glass or different lights, research the different variations of a stamp and have all the books or computers you need to do the research without having to buy everything yourself, find a place to keep it or be constantly harassed by a dealer trying to sell you something. If there is enough interest I might even let Ashley make coffee every day. We are working out the details how all that will come together. Remember, neither Ashley nor I are experts (although we know a couple of people who think they are) and at the moment my reference library is somewhat limited.
