Due to the continuing, ridiculous cost increases at the USPS, we are going to try to go electronic starting with the next auction. If you want a catalog mailed to you in the future -please sign up during viewing week or send me a letter or E-Mail telling me you want a hard copy catalog mailed to you otherwise you will be able to find the catalog on the website and print it out yourself. I will continue to E-Mail you when the catalog is available online.

Viewing week will be from 1 until 6 pm daily, Monday 10 July—Saturday 15 July.
Sunday viewing will continue to be by appointment only for only those of you driving more than 75 miles to get here.

The doors to the auction floor will open at 12:45 on the Sunday the 19th and the Auction will start at 13:30.

Because several of you thought the book auction should be listed in the catalog, we put them in. You will find them numbered as Lots 544 thru 587 and they will be on the bookshelf and front table during viewing. If you want to bid on any of the books (lots 544-587) give one of us your bids during viewing because the floor auction will stop with Lot 543 .

The Local Handling Fee remains in effect.: Local shipments to buyers with shipping addresses less than 30.1 miles from the auction floor as the crow flies will pay a Handling Fee of $\$ 10.00$ plus $5 \%$ of the total cost of your order for the convenience of having your items shipped.

Credit Cards are still accepted: There will be 3\% fee to cover the processing companies fees.
The Greater Kansas City Stamp Show will be held again on 22 and 23 September 2023.

1. The TERMS OF SALE are payment upon delivery or upon receipt of Invoice.
2. The catalog identifies the minimum bid required. Bids below the minimum will be rejected.

Ex. If minimum bid is $\$ 40.00$ and your bid is $\$ 38.00$-your bid will be rejected.
3. Bids must be made in the standard increment, if not they will be reduced to the next lower standard increment.

Ex. If your bid $\$ 119.00$ (which is between the $\$ 110.00$ and $\$ 120.00$ standard amounts) it will be reduced to $\$ 110.00$.
4. Any bid unpaid is subject to late charge of $5 \%$ of the total per month until the items are paid for in full. If legal action is required all expenses are to be paid by the bidder and will be added to the amount owed.
5. Title will not pass to the buyer until final payment is received by $E$ \& $D$ Stamp Auction, LLC.
6. Items shipped will have the cost of postage and insurance added to the invoice. Sales tax will be collected on total purchase price when and where applicable.
7. Any lot with an incorrect description must be returned within 7 days of receipt for a refund. Lots containing more than 10 items or described as having faults, "As Is" or "Mixed Condition" are not returnable for any reason.
8. A buyers premium of $10 \%$ will be added to the hammer price as part of your total purchase price on all lots.
9. Consigner Checks will be mailed on the 45th day after the date of the auction.
10.Unsold consignment lots will continue to be offered after the auction until the auction is closed at the opening bid price. All items sold are subject to sales tax and buyers premium the same as if you had won them during the auction.
