Shipping: Shipping will still be handled the same. The local handling fee of \$10.00 plus 5% will be added to orders if you live within 75 miles as the crow flies.

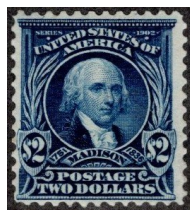
