Remember he's here even during now auction weeks: Tuesday through Friday 1:00 to – 5:00. And he makes appointments if you can't get here between his normal hours.

If you need to make arrangements for Sunday viewing please remember these appointments are only for those of you driving more than 75 miles each way. The doors to the auction floor will open at 12:45 on Sunday 26 April, 2026 and we will begin auctioning at 13:30. (1:30pm)
