In the back of one of the boxes he was working on he found a rolled up plastic bag filled with MNH plate block duck stamps. Ashley went through and priced them for this auction, **so lets get quackin'...** 🐥

Ashley has been reorganizing the back store room and doing inventory and has informed me that the next auction will have to be UN heavy. I have been avoiding it since I know many of you are not UN collectors—but Ashley is refusing to work up any “good lots that you guys want” if no one is helping move the UN stuff. **To keep the peace if you are a UN collector, know a UN collector at your Stamp club or met one at a stamp show, please, please tell them that our next auction will be UN heavy.**
